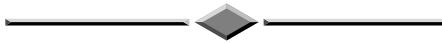




Questions and Answers::

- 1) *What do you mean they are joining together (what do you mean by amalgamation)?*
 - Our two agencies will become one agency and bring together all of our resources (staff, computers, furniture, etc.) to enable us to serve you even better
- 2) *When will this happen?*
 - *In 2018* – but we can't give you an exact date because a few legal things need to happen first, but here is what has happened so far:
 - A joint committee of the two agencies has been meeting for a year
 - A Facilitator has been hired to move the process along
 - A new Board of Directors will be appointed soon
 - Staff from each agency have been meeting together to work out how to serve you even better
- 3) *Will I continue to have the same worker?*
 - Yes. For the time being, you will have the same worker, but just like any other agency, we cannot guarantee that your worker will stay in the same job.
- 4) *Will I still get my Passport dollars (or any Direct Funding dollars, such as Out of Home Respite Funding)? [Note – this is only for DS services!]*
 - Yes, getting your Passport dollars or any Direct Funding dollars will NOT CHANGE at all
- 5) *Will you still come visit me in my home?*
 - If your worker is currently visiting you at home, that WILL continue
- 6) *What if I need help to get to the Info Session?*
 - I will do my best to help you get to the Info Session. What do you think you may need?
- 7) *Is the government/the Ministry/MCSS aware of this/do they support it?*
 - Yes, they are very aware and they do support it! There has just been a Joint Board Meeting with MCSS held on October 24th
